You have asked us about conflict minerals, which are defined in the Dodd-Frank Act as cassiterite (the mineral from which tin is derived), columbite-tantalite, coltan (the mineral from which tantalum is extracted), gold and wolframite (the mineral from which tungsten is derived).

Aleris Rolled Products, LLC has conducted an inquiry with its manufacturing facilities, all of which are located in the United States, and determined that it does not use conflict minerals in manufacturing its flat rolled products.*
